The protection of your personal data is very important to us. We therefore process your data exclusively on the basis of the statutory provisions (DSGVO, DSG2018, TKG 2003). In this data protection declaration we inform you about the most important aspects of data processing on our website.

Personal data

Personal data that you transmit electronically on this website, such as name, e-mail address, address or other personal information, will only be used by us for the specified purpose, stored securely and only passed on to third parties for the implementation of this project. The provider automatically collects and saves information on the web server such as the browser used, operating system, referring page, IP address, time of access, etc. This data cannot be assigned to a specific person without checking other data sources and we do not further evaluate this data as long as none illegal use of our website exists.

Contact us

If you contact us by e-mail, telephone, fax, letter or in person, your data or IP addresses will be stored by us for six months in order to process the request and in the event of follow-up questions. We do not pass on this data without your consent.

Access data / server log files

We collect data about every access to the offer (so-called server log files). The access data include:

Name of the accessed website, file, date and time of access, amount of data transferred, notification of successful access, browser type and version, the user's operating system, referrer URL (the previously visited page), IP address and the requesting provider.

We use the log data only for statistical evaluations for the purpose of operation, security and optimization of the offer. However, we reserve the right to check the log data retrospectively if, based on specific indications, there is a justified suspicion of illegal use.

Your IP address is recorded, but pseudonymized immediately. This means that only a rough localization is possible.

Cookies

Our website uses so-called cookies. These are small text files that are stored on your device with the help of the browser. They do no harm.

For example, cookie data can look like this:

A browser should be able to support these minimum sizes:

At least 4096 bytes per cookie At least 50 cookies per domain At least 3000 cookies in total

We use cookies to make our offer user-friendly. Some cookies remain stored on your device until you delete them. The purpose of using these cookies is to be able to offer optimal user guidance as well as to recognize visitors and to be able to present an attractive website and interesting content with repeated use.

We use so-called session cookies or temporary cookies to optimize our online offer. A session cookie is a small text file that is sent by the respective server when you visit a website and is temporarily stored on your hard drive. This file as such contains a so-called session ID, with which various requests from your browser can be assigned to the common session. This means that your computer can be recognized when you return to our website. These cookies are deleted after you close your browser. They serve z. B. to the fact that you can use the shopping cart function across several pages.

To a lesser extent, we also use persistent cookies (also small text files that are stored on your device) that remain on your device and enable us to recognize your browser the next time you visit. These cookies are stored on your hard drive and delete themselves after the specified time. Their lifespan is 1 month to 10 years. In this way, we can present our offer to you in a more user-friendly, effective and secure manner and, for example, show you information on the page that is specifically tailored to your interests. The content of a permanent cookie is limited to an identification number. Name, IP address etc. are not saved. An individual profile of your usage behavior does not take place.

Our legitimate interest in the use of cookies in accordance with Article 6 (1) (f) GDPR lies in making our website more user-friendly, more effective and safer.

The following data and information are stored in the cookies:

Log-in information

- Language settings
- entered search terms

- Information about the number of visits to our website and the use of individual functions of our website.

When the cookie is activated, an identification number is assigned to it and your personal data is not assigned to this identification number. Your name, your IP address or similar data that would enable the cookie to be assigned to you are not stored in the cookie. On the basis of cookie technology, we only receive pseudonymized information, for example about which pages of our shop were visited, which products were viewed, etc.

You can deactivate the storage of cookies in your browser, limit them to certain websites or set your web browser (Chrome, IE, Firefox, ...) so that it notifies you as soon as a cookie is sent. You can also delete cookies from your PC's hard drive at any time. Please note, however, that in this case you will have to reckon with a limited display of the page and limited user guidance. You can make changes to the cookie settings here.

If you want to find out which cookies have been stored in your browser, if you want to change or delete cookie settings, you can find this in your browser settings:

In order to make it easier for you to deal with the cookies we set, we have implemented a cookie consent tool that explains the cookies we use when you visit our website for the first time (name, purpose, lifespan, provider, etc.). This allows you to individually agree to the use of cookies before they are set. You can revise the selection you have made at any time in the menu item "Cookies Settings".

Piwik PRO

This website uses Piwik PRO, a software to perform web analysis. The service provider is the German company Piwik PRO GmbH, Kurfürstendamm 21, 10719 Berlin in Germany. SSL encryption

This site uses SSL encryption for security reasons and to protect the transmission of confidential content, such as the inquiries and orders that you send to us as the site operator. If SSL encryption is not activated, the data that you transmit to us can be read by third parties.

Your rights
